Academy of Applied Technical and Preschool Studies follows the ECTS scheme, which means that ECTS credits are allocated to course units, lectures, practical work, etc. at each department. In ECTS, 60 credits represent one year of study (in terms of workload); normally 30 credits are given for the period of six months (a term/semester). Serbian grading system in higher education is based on a 6 to 10 scale, where 6 is the lowest limit of knowledge and 10 is the highest mark.
